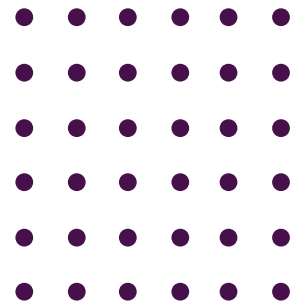


# 10 QUESTIONS YOU SHOULD ASK YOUR DOCTOR ABOUT IBS



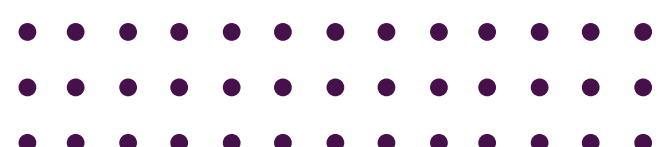
1. Why do you think IBS is the right diagnosis for me?

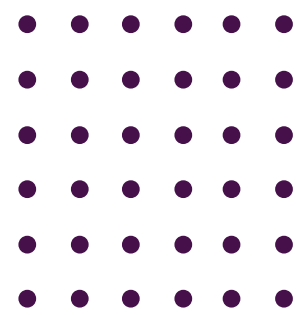
2. Would you recommend a colonoscopy for me? Why or why not?
